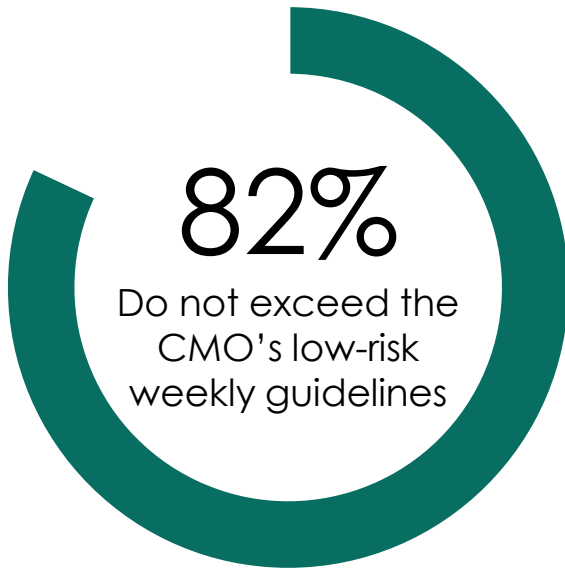
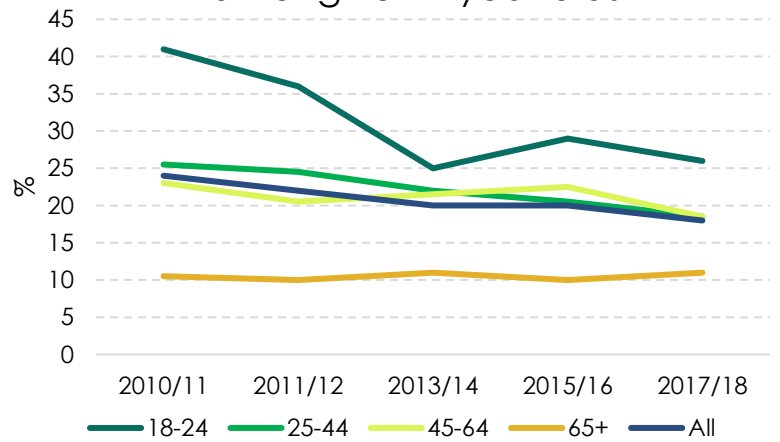


- Increased risk drinking continues to fall across all age groups, most notably 18-24 year olds

- Whilst alcohol-related violence has fluctuated since 2012, alcohol-related public disorder has almost halved

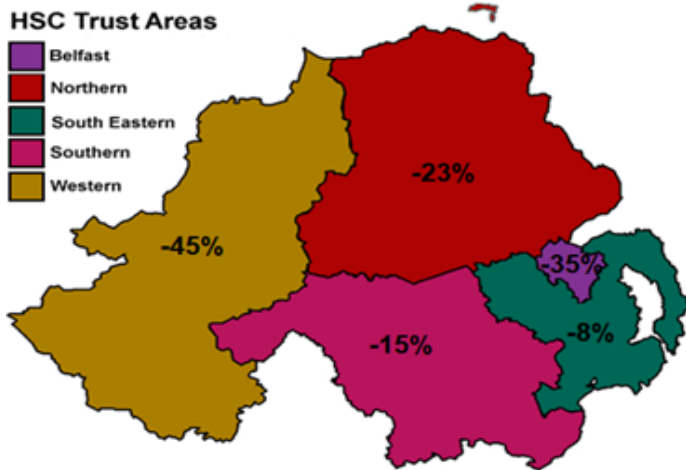


'Increased risk' drinking is falling across age groups, with a **36%** fall among 18-24 year olds

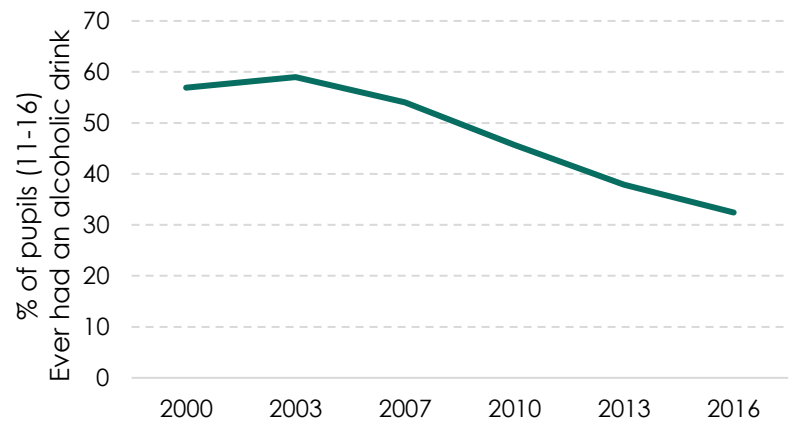

Since 2010, those drinking above CMO guidelines have fallen across NI

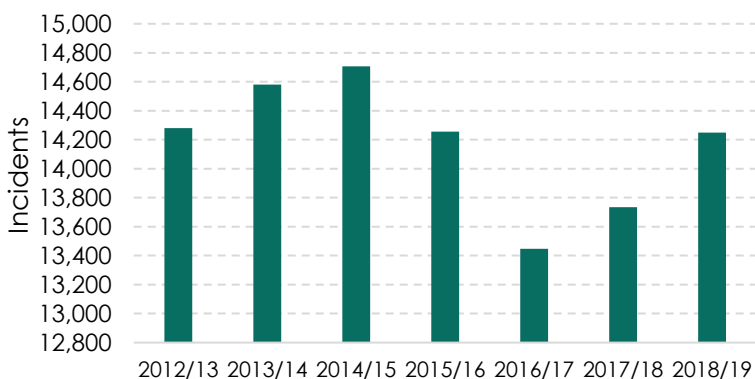


Underage drinking has fallen **43%** since 2000



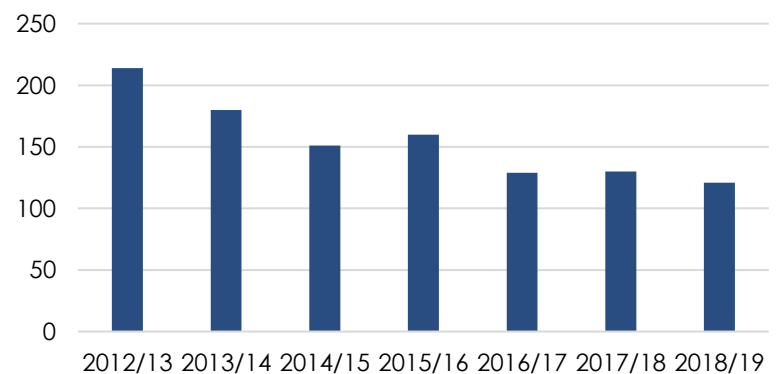
